

Native American Ownership Statistics 2024



In 2021, there were 402,582 Native American-owned firms in the U.S.
Native American-owned businesses employed 307,933 workers, paid \$12.9 billion in payroll, and generated \$66.9 billion in sales.

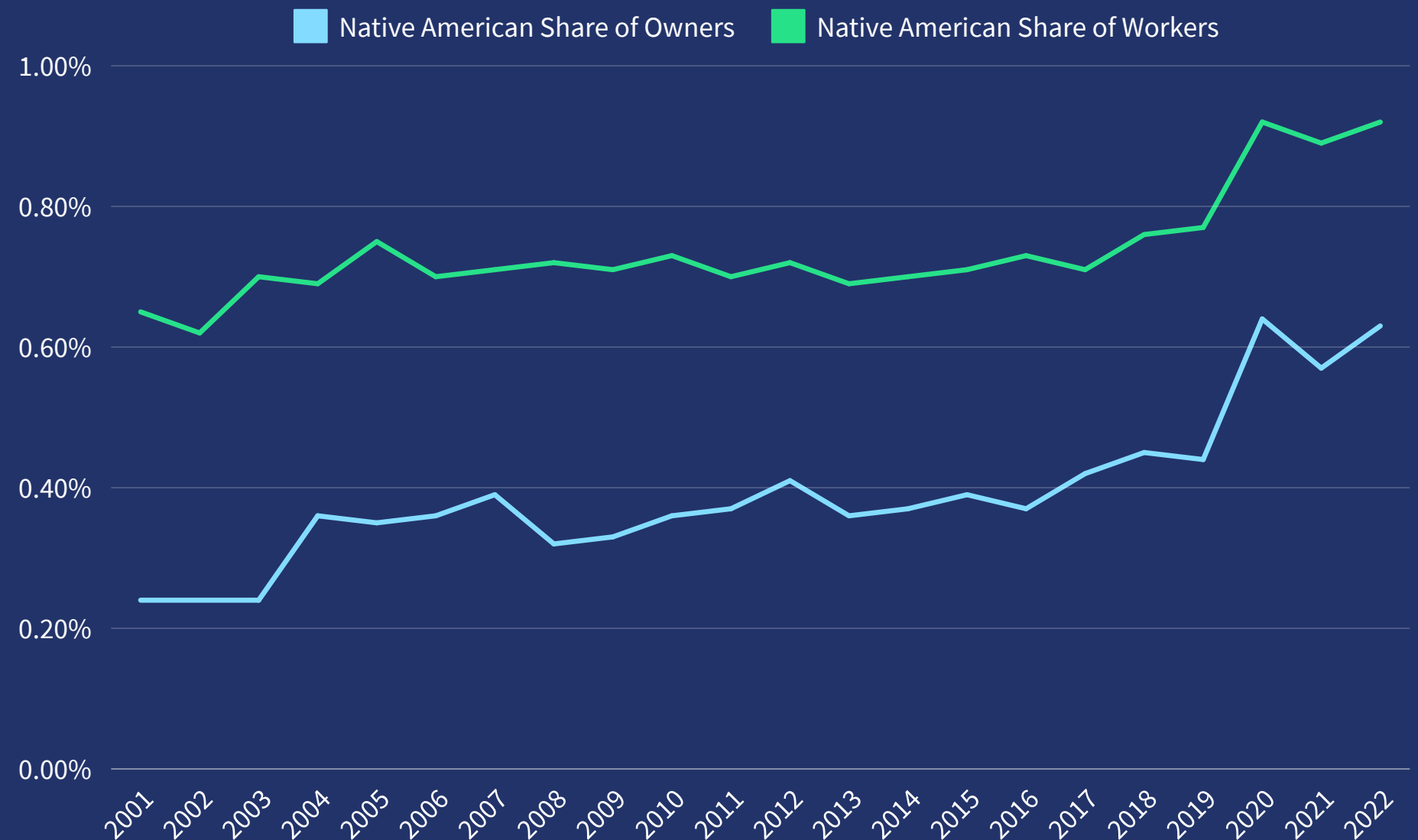

Native American Ownership Statistics 2024

Native American business owners represented 0.6% of all owners in 2022 compared to 0.9% of the overall labor force. The total number of Native American owners increased almost 16% from the prior year.

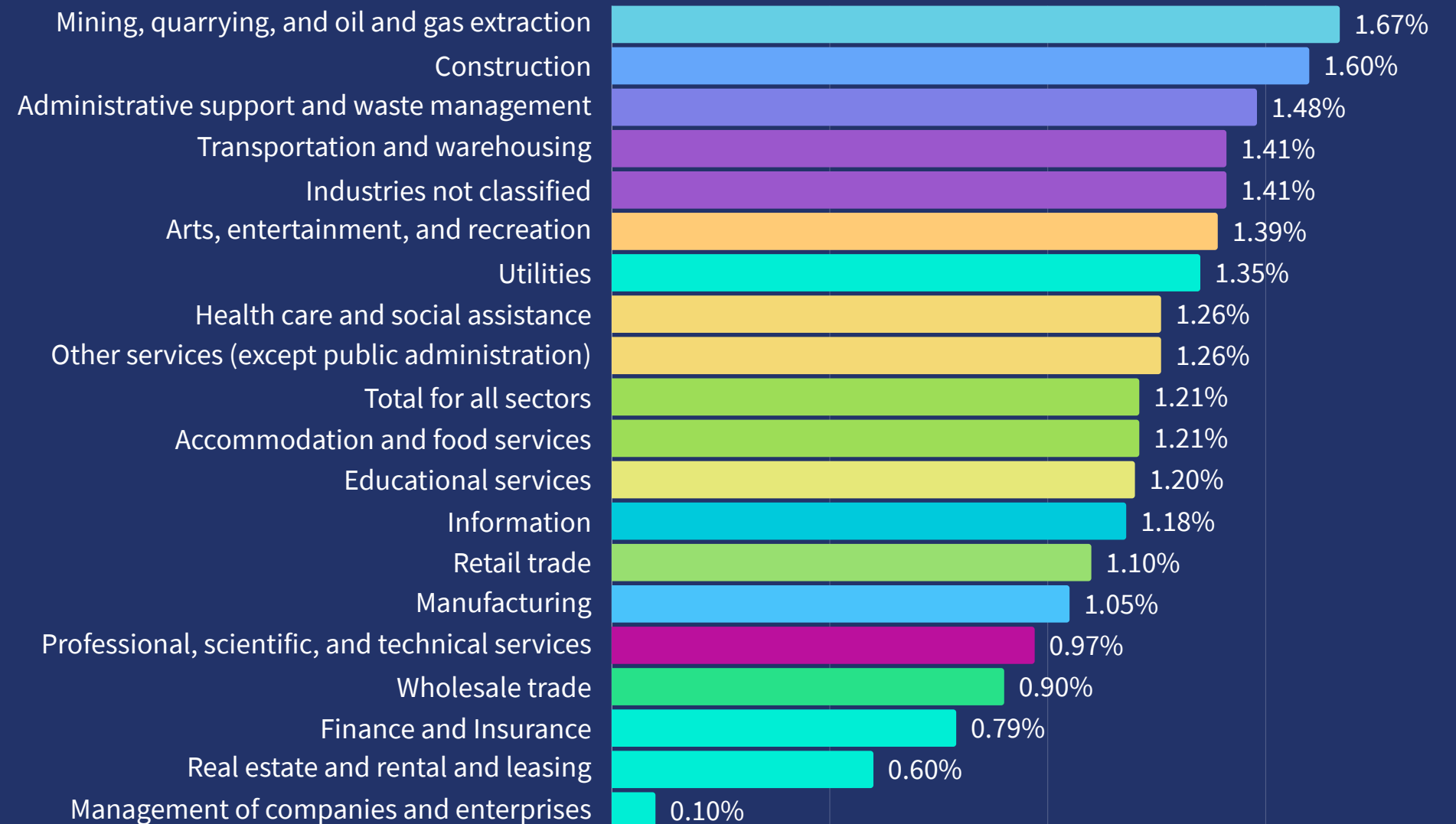


Native American Ownership Statistics 2024

In 2021, Native American-owned firms represented 1.2% of firms in the United States. The highest share of Native American-owned firms was in the Mining and Gas sector, while the most Native American-owned businesses were in the Construction sector.
